TUITION

North Attleboro Residents: \$175 per course, with a \$25 registration fee (total \$200.00)

Non-Residents: \$225 per course, with a \$25 registration fee (total \$250.00)
(Non-residents should inquire at their respective schools in advance to ascertain whether academic credit will/will not be accepted.)

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will be given only when a class has been cancelled due to low enrollment.

No refunds will be given if a student is excluded from any program for disciplinary or attendance reasons. (Please refer to discipline and attendance policies)

DISCIPLINE

All rules and regulations that are part of North Attleboro High School and North Attleboro Middle School's discipline codes are in effect. All students are expected to treat teachers and fellow students with respect. Failure to exhibit proper standards of behavior will result in immediate removal from the program and **loss of tuition fees** paid. Course academic credit **will not** be issued for students removed from the program.

Smoking anywhere on school grounds is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. Any students violating this policy are subject to **dismissal from the program**. No fees will be refunded.

ATTENDANCE

Students should be in attendance **every day**. A doctor's note or court officer's note will excuse a student's absence (maximum of three days). **All work** missed due to any absence must be completed to obtain credit. Students may be absent unexcused only **one** time in any session. Students who exceed **one** unexcused absence **will be dismissed** from the program. **No refund** will be given to students who are dismissed from the program. No course academic credit will be given to students who are dismissed from the program.

Students are expected to be **on time for classes** each day. Excessive tardiness could result in **dismissal from the program**. Course credit will not be issued and course registration fees will be forfeited if a student is dismissed because of excessive tardiness.

OTHER

Proper dress is required.

Transportation to and from summer school is the responsibility of the parent.

Smoking is **prohibited** on **school grounds**.

The use of radios, CD players, headphones, cell phones, pagers, and other "electronic devices" **is not permitted during class time**.
