When are physicals required?

All newly enrolled Students as well as Grades PreK, K, 4, 7, 10 and each year for High School sports.

When should I keep my Child home?

When your child has:

1. A contagious illness such as the flu, chicken pox or strep throat.
2. An undiagnosed rash or skin condition.
3. A fever over 100° within the past 24 hours.
4. Suspected eye infection.
5. Vomiting or diarrhea within the past 24 hours.

When should I call my Child's School Nurse?

When your child has:

1. A new medication prescribed.
2. A new medical diagnosis.
3. A serious injury, illness or hospitalization.
4. A fracture, sprain, stitches or a cast.
