As we prepare for student learning to commence next Wednesday, September 16th, we want to remind you that all students will participate remotely on the first day of school. Please check your emails over the next few days for important information from each school regarding class lists and log-in procedures for September 16th. All North Attleborough Public Schools staff members have been working diligently to prepare for the start of school, and we are looking forward to welcoming all students back next week.

We also wanted to share some exciting news with you regarding food service. The USDA has extended a waiver allowing North Attleborough Public Schools to serve free breakfast and free lunch to **ALL** students in our entire school district until December 31, 2020 or as long as funds are available. This news means that we are able to now provide every North Attleborough student with nutritious and nourishing food for **FREE** supporting them at school and at home. Children will receive a healthy breakfast and healthy lunch every school day, at no cost. This applies to students who are attending school in the hybrid model or the fully remote model. More information will be provided in a separate letter from Heather Baril, Director of School Nutrition.
