### Curriculum

The program at North Attleborough High School is rigorous and designed to prepare all students for postsecondary education. We are mindful that all students do not learn the same way and are deserving of an individualized approach. Core subject courses are offered in these levels:

**Level 2:** Students thrive in a structured learning environment that supports the development of their academic and organizational skills.

**Level 1:** Students must thrive in a guided learning environment and be motivated, conscientious, and organized.

**Advanced Placement/Honors:** Students must thrive in an independent learning environment and thus, must be self-motivated, conscientious, organized and have a passion for the subject.

## Results

The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education ranked North Attleborough High School 31st out of 281 participating Massachusetts high schools in the percentage of students obtaining qualifying AP test scores (3, 4, or 5). North Attleborough High School ranked **second** in Hockomock League schools for the percentage of students obtaining qualifying AP test scores.
