

Bus Pass Procedure & Eligibility

2019-2020

- **All** households need to apply annually if bus service is desired.
- Students in Grades K – 6 are eligible for free bus service if they reside 2 or more miles from the assigned school. Students in grades K-6 who reside between 1.25 to 1.99 miles from the assigned school, and all students in grades 7-12 may apply for fee based bus transportation. Please note that K-5 students are considered “walkers” if they reside under 1.25 miles from the assigned school. Grade 6 students are considered “walkers” if they reside under 2 miles from school. Requests will be considered based upon space availability on buses assigned to the bus route, date of application, safety and distance from the assigned school.
- Complete one application per household listing the names of all students in the household who will be riding the bus and the school they will be attending. **If you believe you qualify for free busing, you will also need to fill out a Fee Waiver Application and submit the required Proof of income paperwork.**
- Submit completed application and appropriate fee to North Attleborough Public Schools Transportation Department, 6 Morse Street, North Attleborough, MA 02760 by July 6, 2019.
- If you are paying for a bus pass online, you do not need to submit an application for that/those student(s). The online payment is considered your application. You may pay online by going to MySchoolBucks.com. A link is available on Naschools.net.
- All bus applications that do not qualify for a fee waiver and are received without the proper payment amount will be returned to you unprocessed. A student will not be issued a bus pass unless all fees or charges are paid or waived.
- Prior to the start of school, bus routes will be published in The Sun Chronicle and The Free Press for specific pick up and drop off locations.
- **Bus passes will be mailed during the first two weeks of August.** Students are required to carry a current year bus pass starting on the first day of school.
- Bus pickup and drop off locations will be determined by the North Attleborough School Department with exceptions being made if/when road, safety and weather conditions dictate differently.
- The school district does not prorate the fee for one-way transportation or for less than full use.
- **NO** refunds after September 1, 2019.
