As we all work to ensure the safety and security of our school buildings, we wanted to let you know that the school offices will be asking any visitors to the school to state their name and the purpose of their visit when being buzzed into the schools. This goes for all parents picking up students, as well as any visitors or parent volunteers. Once in the main office, please be prepared to show your ID and the administrative staff will write out your name badge. Sticker name badges need to be visible when visiting the schools at all times. If you are sending a relative or grandparent to pick up your child or children, please have them bring their license with them to the school. We will also have some different procedures for concerts and other large events at the school and will share information about special events at a later time.

On another note, we will likely be conducting several safety drills with the students over the next few months including Fire Drills and Lockdown Drills. We will be working in collaboration with the North Attleboro Police and Fire Departments to conduct these drills and will share information with parents once our drills have been completed. We understand that drills can sometimes be stressful for young students and we always prepare students for these drills using child appropriate language and information.
