

Work Permits

All children between the ages of 14 and 17 are required to obtain work permits before beginning employment (G.L. c. 149, §§ 86-89).

A **Work Permit Application** must be completed before a permit can be issued. These applications can be downloaded off this site, picked up at the Main Office at the High School or Middle School, or at the Woodcock Administration Building. Included with this application are the Work Hours and Occupation Restrictions.

For students ages 14 and 15, the Physicians portion of the application MUST BE SIGNED BY THE CHILD'S PHYSICIAN. We cannot accept the physician's annual physical form. Students aged 16 and 17 do not need a physician's signature.

Once the work permit application has been completed by the employer, parent, and physician, it must be presented by the student at the High School Main Office (HS Students only) or the Middle School Main Office (MS students only).

For those North Attleboro students who do not attend school in North Attleboro; Applications and Work Permits can be obtained at the Woodcock Administration Building between the hours of 8:30-12:30 p.m. and 1:30-3:00 p.m. A birth certificate, license, or passport must be presented, by the student, along with the application.

For **Out of Town Students**; working papers are only issued to those students who will be working in North Attleboro and must be presented by the student.
