Class Dues: Senior class dues must be paid in full. **Caps and gowns are paid out of class dues.** Class dues will need to be paid up to date for each year of attendance at North Attleborough High School. The class dues for each year are as follows: \$10.00 for freshman year; \$10.00 for sophomore year; \$15.00 for junior year and \$15.00 for senior year. For out-of-district students, an additional fee of \$25.00 will be needed to cover the cost of caps and gowns.

Senior Awards Night and Reception: Senior Awards Night will be held on Wednesday, June 3, 2020, at 6:00 PM in the Kenneth Pickering Gymnasium. Senior Awards Night will consist of the presentation of academic awards & scholarships. Students should plan to arrive at 5:30 PM. Immediately following Senior Class Night will be the Senior Class Reception in the North Attleborough High School Cafeteria. Parents are invited to attend the reception to extend their best wishes to the graduating seniors. Light refreshments will be provided in the cafeteria.

Fisher Kelly: The 99th Senior Athletic Fisher-Kelley Banquet, honoring senior student-athletes at North Attleborough High School, will be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2020. The banquet will take place at the **Attleboro Elks Lodge #1014 at 887 South Main Street beginning at 6:30 PM**. The student athletes are guests of the Fisher-Kelley Banquet Committee. The Committee will provide for their meals and awards. Parents are cordially invited to attend at a cost of **\$25.00** per ticket. Due to the limited availability of seating, each family is restricted to purchasing a maximum of four tickets. Tickets will be available through the Athletic Director's office beginning April 1, 2020. Please **pay by check only**, payable to North Attleborough High School. This is a wonderful night that celebrates the achievements of our senior student athletes. Appropriate dress code for the night will require that girls wear a dress or pantsuit, and boys will wear dress pants with a shirt and tie.

Scholarships: Attached please find two (2) application forms for local scholarships. The first is for the North Attleborough High School Scholarship Committee, and the other is for the North Attleborough Scholarship Foundation. **These are two separate scholarships, please do not attach them as one.** Also, listed on Naviance there are a myriad of other scholarship applications including but not limited to the NA Junior Football Scholarship, the James Rice Scholarship, and the Jack Strachan Scholarship. Students are encouraged to log into Naviance for a complete listing of scholarships or stop by the Guidance Office. The enclosed scholarship applications must be completed in their entirety and returned to **Mrs. Kummer in the main office. Please be aware that late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**

Health Records: Please be advised that the High School nurses will be distributing Massachusetts Health Records to each senior. This will require the student's signature upon receipt. The health record should be placed in a secure location, as the information may be needed at a later date. If you do not want your child to pick up their health record, please contact school nurses Mrs. Coady or Mrs. Sandland and indicate when you will be retrieving the record. **Please note that if these records are not picked up, they will be destroyed within five (5) years, as the law requires.**

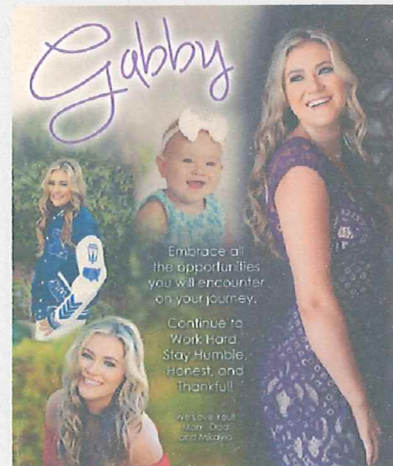
