Due to popular demand, Practices and ALL Games will be held in town between North Attleboro teams
DIVISIONS SET UP AS FOLLOWS: WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REDUCE/INCREASE THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS PER DIVISION BASED ON NUMBER OF TEAMS NEEDED
PreK: \$75, practice/play 8 Saturday mornings including Parade Day
Kindergarten: \$75, practice/play 8 Saturday mornings including Parade Day
Grades 1: \$75, practice/play 8 Saturday mornings Parade Day
Grades 2 & 3 and Grades 4 & 5 & 6: \$75, will play 10 games during the 8-week season. To accommodate having 3 teams per division, teams will have a rotating schedule of weekly practices and weeknight and Saturday games (one team per week will be playing both a weeknight and Saturday game).
Games and Practices will be held at Kelly Field.
Practices start the week of April 22nd.

We will be holding games Memorial Day weekend.
