KIDS: Summer Art Weeks

The Attleboro Arts Museum's weeklong summer art sessions combine looking at professional artwork in the Museum gallery with fun, age-appropriate art-making experiences in the Museum studios. Students will try new approaches, materials and gain self-confidence. Our faculty of artist/educators will provide individualized attention to our budding artists.

Costs: (NOTE: *Early Bird & Sibling discounts cannot be combined and only apply to our summer art weeks*)

July 1 – 5 (This is a 4-day week; no class on Thurs, July 4th):

Full-day: 9am-3pm. \$204 mem; \$228 non-mem (materials included)

Half-day: 9am-12:30pm. \$127 mem; \$152 non-mem (materials included)

Standard 5-day week:

Full-day: 9am-3pm, Mon-Fri. \$249 mem; \$279 non-mem (materials included)

Half-day: 9am-12:30pm, Mon-Fri. \$154 mem; \$184 non-mem (materials included)

Our half-day option only applies to the 9am-12:30pm timeframe. No exceptions, thank you.

• **Early Bird Registration Special:** 10% off tuition costs if you enroll by April 1st, 2019.

WEEK 5: July 29 – Aug 2	morning: Drawing	afternoon: Sculpture (non-clay)
WEEK 6: August 5 – 9	morning: Printmaking	afternoon: Painting
WEEK 7: August 12 – 16	morning: Sculpture (non-clay)	afternoon: Chalk Pastels
WEEK 8: August 19 – 23	morning: Cartooning	afternoon: Oil Pastels

• **Ages 5-8: Bobble Heads, Bunnies & Bowls in Clay w/Sandra Barrett, (6 wks) Thurs, July 18-Aug 22; 9:00-10:30am.** Learn pinch pot, slab and coil techniques. Costs: \$153 mem, \$165 non-mem (*materials included*).

• **Ages 9-13: Form, Fire, Glaze, REPEAT! Mastering the Potter's Wheel w/Sandra Barrett, (6 wks) Thurs, July 18- Aug 22; 11am-1pm.** Imaginative hand-building, wheel throwing & sculpture projects. Costs: \$163 mem, \$176 non-mem (*materials included*).

NEW! TEENS AGES 13-17: Sculpting Horses w/Judith Bertozzi, (2-days) Tues, July 16 & Wed, July 17; 1-3pm. Create 3-D horse sculptures using plaster & wire. Costs: \$69 mem; \$76 non-mem (*materials included*).
