CHILD FIND

It is the responsibility of the North Attleborough Public Schools to identify any child who may have a disability who is a resident of North Attleborough or who attends private school within the geographic boundaries of North Attleborough. This also includes students who are in a district approved home-school program.

North Attleborough Public Schools is also responsible for the evaluation of those students to determine if they are eligible for special education or related services under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) or 603 CMR 28 (Massachusetts Special Education Regulations).

The North Attleborough school district is also committed to identifying children before their third birthday in order to provide early intervention services for three and four year-olds with disabilities. If you have questions or concerns regarding your child's development and would like to have him/her screened, please call the Early Learning Center for an appointment at (508) 643-2145 to set up an appointment.

If you suspect that your child may need an evaluation to determine eligibility for special education services, you may request an evaluation, at no cost, through the North Attleborough Public Schools Office of Student Services. Please contact the Office of Student Services at the following:
