Public Hearing Meeting

The North Attleborough School Committee met on Monday, January 14, 2013 at 7:00 in North Attleboro Police Department's EOC Conference Room.

Committee members included: Carol Wagner, Joan Meilan, Neal Gouck, Chip Poirier, Chris Frost, Kevin O'Donnell and James McKenna.

Superintendent Suzan Cullen, Assistant Superintendent Joel Antolini, Business Administrator David Flynn and Kyle Kummer, Director of Facilities and Grounds represented the central office.

Chairman Frost called the meeting to order at 7:01. The pledge of allegiance and a moment of silence for veterans who have given the ultimate sacrifice followed.

Chairman Frost introduced Superintendent Cullen to present the FY2014 School Department Budget as recommended by the Budget Subcommittee.

Superintendent Cullen began by thanking the administrative team for their collaboration in formulating this budget. Superintendent Cullen focused on the District's mission, vision and core values, including:

- Student Achievement
- Respectful Learning Community
- Collaboration Enhanced Through Communication
- Resources

Superintendent Cullen proposed a budget increase of 9.6% for a total of \$37,068,35 . Key components of the budget include maintaining staff, reinstating lost positions, sustaining technology advances, and increasing District Curriculum.

Superintendent Cullen concluded her presentation at 7:37 and the public was invited to comment. Chairman Frost called for a motion to conclude the public hearing. So moved by Mr. McKenna and seconded by Mr. Gouck so voted and passed unanimously.
