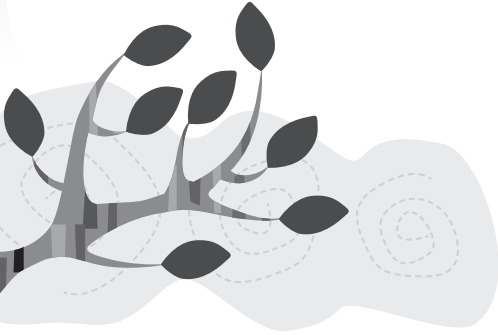




# Summer Reading Skills

### Program for 4-Year-Olds and Entering Kindergartners

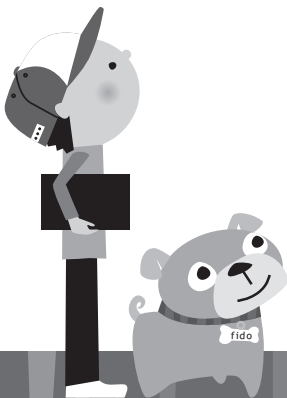
